

## Ezekiel – week #9 (wrap up)

The overall message of Ezekiel is that God will accomplish his will in spite of Israel's rebellion and the perceived power of nations.

The main issues pointed out for which God punished Israel were \_\_\_\_\_ 6:4-13, 8:10, 14:4-5, 16:36 (here with child sacrifice) & \_\_\_\_\_ 7:10 & 23, 8:17 & 12:19

### Important points in Ezekiel's message

- 1) God said based on what he would do, "They shall \_\_\_\_\_ that I am the Lord" (5:13 first time but multiple times)
- 2) God's shows us his four severe judgements [5:16-17 & 14:21] – #1) \_\_\_\_\_ – #2) \_\_\_\_\_ – #3) \_\_\_\_\_ – #4) \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) There will be a \_\_\_\_\_ left of Israel (5:8)
- 4) They will be judged "according to their \_\_\_\_\_" (7:1 first time but multiple times)
- 5) The \_\_\_\_\_ will be marked (9:1-6)
- 6) The \_\_\_\_\_ of God leaves the \_\_\_\_\_ (10:18)
- 7) The \_\_\_\_\_ shall not bear the \_\_\_\_\_ of the father (18:1-4 & 20)

- 9) Judgements over nations who were Israel's \_\_\_\_\_ (25-32 & others)

### The reassuring message of restoration (seen in multiple passages)

- ⇒ The valley of dry bones of chapter 37 signifies God will resurrect the nation so that his "\_\_\_\_\_ place" shall be with them (see especially 37:24-28)
- ⇒ Magog & Gog from chapters 38 & 39 assure Israel that their enemies will not \_\_\_\_\_ over them (see especially 39:21-29 where God reassures them of a restoration)

⇒ The detailed description of the \_\_\_\_\_ and its service in chapters 40-48 I believe is a foretaste of not only the restoration of the nation but of the coming \_\_\_\_\_

A. 43: 10-12 – God told Ezekiel to make this plan known to the exiles who were \_\_\_\_\_ of what they had done so that they would “do” it
